- Minimise buver worries there's no need to spend a fortune but do carry out any necessary minor repairs beforehand.

- Viewings be as flexible as possible and let your estate agents know of any specific times to avoid.

Be Prepared to Facilitate the Fastest Sale:

- Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) this is a legal requirement when selling your home. Your estate agent can help get one for you.
- Instruct a solicitor if you do this before you advertise your home, make deeds and searches available, this could save 3-4 weeks once the sale is agreed.
- Fixtures and fittings prepare an inventory of what will be included in the sale to give the buyer an idea of what they are getting.

Planning for the Big Move

- Remember to book a removal company and storage if needed. Save time by ordering boxes and packing yourself.
- **Change of address -** remember to notify your utilities and internet providers, bank, the DVLA and your local council.
- Final bills provide utilities with final readings and help your buyer by leaving details of the services the property is connected to.
- Redirect your post there's a charge but it's worth it. Visit royalmail.co.uk for forms.
